CRYPTO'S TWINJET settled just off the leaders while racing four wide into the stretch, responded readily when set down to make the lead at the sixteenth pole and won going away. ASINAWAY sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, set the pace until deep stretch and finished second best. KIND OF FUN outrun for a half, had a mild late rally. TISOURTURN prompted the pace into the stretch, steadied a bit nearing the furlong marker and weakened. COME HITHER failed to reach a contending position. PRINTER'S PRINCESS went evenly while no threat. BATES CHOICE was always outrun. MISS HOLY TOLEDO trailed.
