ACADEMIST dueled for the lead from the inside, gained a clear lead at the quarter pole, drew off through the lane under a strong hand ride. AFTERTHEBALLISOVER well placed throughout, could not gain on winner through the stretch but held place. NO EXPOSURE outrun early, rallied in the stretch and closed willingly. STAGE DOOR PENNY well placed and saved ground, had an even effort. MY LAST DOLLAR dueled with the winner, weakened in the stretch. PRIMAL BEAUTY allowed to settle, failed to menace. DRIVING MS CHELSEA had good position, lacked a late bid. TRAVELING SUSIE raced wide and was no threat. PAINT MY DREAMS was outrun.
