CUSACK taken in hand to be unhurried, circled horses five wide on the turn, made the lead at the top of the stretch and drew off to win as much the best. REGWELL had speed from the start along the rail, was in tight on the turn then came on again one clear at the eighth pole and finished clear for second. LARMON settled just off the leaders and finished with good courage. GOOD CREDENTIALS was hustled from the start to set a pressured pace two wide into the stretch then weakened. PRIME RATE passed tiring horses late while no threat. KRIS'S HONOR failed to menace. DICK WHITTINGTON was outrun. NOBUDDY prompted the pace three wide into the stretch then gave way. LATIN SAILOR was through after a half.
