REAPINGTHEREWARDS sprinted up between horses to gain a slight lead before a quarter, set the balance of the pace under pressure, edged clear in deep stretch and prevailed under energetic handling. SCALD trailed into the stretch then closed willingly three wide and got up for second. EXTREME TAKEOVER also unhurried but never far back, loomed boldly four wide into the stretch then leveled off. FLUFFY'S GIRL within striking distance from the start, finished well five wide. BRADS NUMBER ONE prompted the pace while hung five wide into the stretch then weakened late. DUE TO FLY was a sharp threat three wide for a half then gave way. MIAMI VALLEY contested the early lead along the rail then tired the final eighth. TRENDY ANGEL had brief speed.
