MAMA'S WONDER BOY prompted the pace two wide into the stretch, made the lead, opened a clear advantage before the eighth pole and prevailed under right handed urging. TRACK RECORD settled just off the dueling leaders, rallied three wide late and was steadily cutting into the winners advantage. MOODY BRUCE set a pressured pace into the stretch then weakened. MIG ALLEY close outside, lacked a closing response. SOIR NOIR was a sharp threat along the rail into the stretch then weakened. VALENTINUS trailed.
