EXCESSIVELYCASUAL was hustled up to make the lead before a quarter, was headed by DEVIOUS BEBE on the turn then fought back to regain the lead in mid stretch and was all out to hold RARE AFFAIR safe. RARE AFFAIR trailed into the stretch, swung six wide for the drive, finished with a burst of speed and just missed getting up in time. DEVIOUS BEBE pressed the pace into the turn, gained a slight advantage before a half, set the pace until mid stretch then weakened. SNOW FORTUNE prompted the early pace, remained a sharp factor until deep stretch and also weakened. BRAZOS SHUTTLE allowed to settle, offered a mild bid into the stretch then came up empty. CALIFORNIA LIMITED was a sharp factor into the stretch then gave way. MS INFINITY SLEW failed to menace. J. C.S JOY was outrun.
