LADY LABEEB never far back, rallied in the upper stretch, angled in to the rail in mid stretch and was gaining late. OHIO VOLUNTEER never far back, had a mild rally late and put in a good effort. MACOCHEE GOLD never far back, lacked a late response and went evenly. ESPANOLA off slowly, found her best stride late. MARCY'S HOPE failed to menace. LIGHT ONE well placed for a half, then weakened. LEAH'S DOLLY vied for lead and set the pace, then tired turning for home. YNOP off slowly was outrun.
