WHY US stalked the early pace, rallied on the second turn and gained the lead, drew off in the stretch, driving. EAST END HOUSEWIFE had good position throughout, rallied in late stretch and was up for second. VICTORY DANCE pressed the pace four wide, lacked a late response and went evenly. SEA PRANCER close up for six furlongs, gave way on the second turn. QUICK VERDICT unhurried early, was never a threat. POLITE COMPANY was no factor. PYRITE HALO had early speed and stopped.
