BUZZ TOWN stalked the early pace, rallied at the quarter pole and drew even, widened in the stretch under brisk handling. THE BIG MAN was allowed to settle early, swung six wide in the upper stretch, rallied and was up for place. POWERSTOWN was never far back on the inside, angled out and rallied at the quarter pole three wide, put in his bid and hung late. TAP TIPY TAP well placed on the inside, needed more late. CODE RUNNER hopped at the start and had no speed down the backside, was never a threat. YOUNG APOLLO had good position for a half, gave way in the stretch. CHO had good early speed for a half, then tired.
