GIRLISH GIGGLE came out awkwardly at the start, was allowed to settle, loomed boldly on the second turn and finished second best. SWITCHEROO set the pace into the stretch then weakened. D. J.'S SLEW was in tight along the rail on the first turn, remained close up into the stretch then faded. FETCH ME CAP was no threat. PETIONVILLE LADY was a forward factor for five furlongs then flattened out. BARRA STEEL was outrun. RAKING IN THE GOLD lost her footing at the start then was through after a half. DEVIL'S GIRLFRIEND was outrun. SILVER STEP LASS had brief speed.
