MONUMENT VALLEY outrun early, closed willingly five wide through the stretch and got up in the final strides. BARNYSY allowed to settle, rallied four wide on the second turn, made the lead near the quarter pole, drew clear then could not handle the winner late. IMAHONEYTOO settled just off the leaders, drew on near even terms for the lead on the far turn then leveled off. ASHWOOD C C prompted the pace for a half, made the lead, set the pace until the quarter pole, had speed until the eighth pole then gave way. MOTHER MOLLY BOO set the early pace, was a sharp factor for six furlongs then flattened out. SHARP WAYS trailed.
