GLITTER CANYON was steadied leaving the chute and was allowed to settle, rallied at the quarter pole three wide, gained a clear lead in mid stretch and prevailed late under strong handling. SWEET WATER RIM was away alertly and quickly set the pace with a clear lead, finished willingly and held place. SPEEDY PIONEER unhurried early while four wide, rallied in the upper stretch, finished well and was gaining. BRICKLAND had good position throughout and saved ground, needed more late. BURLEY A allowed to settle, failed to menace. LATIN SAILOR pressed the pace and was through after a half.
