CORE'S WORLD raced in the second flight, rallied in the upper stretch, swung five wide, closed deternienly and wore down her rivals. A LITTLE PETITE was allowed to settle, rallied in the upper stretch four wide, drew even late, was outfinished on the wire. FORMAL WHO stalked the pace, rallied in the upper stretch, finished willingly in a good effort. SPEEDY SUZANNE was well placed and saved ground, put in her bid in mid stretch and drew even, was outfinished late. POLYNESIAN SUNSET dueled early, gained a clear lead down the backside and around the second turn, shortened stride in mid stretch. A BEAUTIFUL DREAM raced four wide, had no rally. PYRITE BOB chased early for three quarters, gave way in the stretch. THIS IS LOVE showed little.
