Footnotes

HONEY BE FLEET was unhurried early, rallied on the second turn on the inside, angled out in the upper stretch three wide with a quick move, drew off under a hand ride. UNTOUCHED was never far back and saved ground, angled out in the upper stretch four wide closed willingly and was second best. GATHERING DREAMS allowed to settle, rallied four wide with a mild bid. PREMIER ROMA dueled early, chased the speed down the backside, put in a bid at the quarter pole, came up empty in the stretch. PYRITE HALO well placed for six furlongs while three wide, gave way in the stretch. GUNS AND GIGGLES dueled early, gained a clear lead down the backside, gave way in the stretch. PROMISED MANDATE was never a threat.
