ERIE WONDER stalked the pace three wide, rallied in the upper stretch, closed determienly and wore down his rivals. LARGEDOUBLEDOUBLE was allowed to settle and saved ground, angled out in mid stretch, finished well and was gaining. TURWADA dueled for the lead the entire trip, was outfinished late. ITZA MAKER never far back, lacked a late response and went evenly. RA'A ACTION slow early, closed a gap five wide while no threat. DOUBLE NAUGHT SPY raced mid pack and was no threat. MACHO MAMBO dueled on the lead for a half, faltered in the stretch. LIARS LIE was no factor. TOM DICK OR HARRY well placed early, was through after a half.
