Footnotes

GEODI'S GOLD was unhurried early and lagged behind, rallied five wide in the stretch, closed with a rush and drew clear late under strong handling. FAST SUMMER was never far back, rallied in the stretch, was outfinished late but held place. SWEET WATER RIM dueled on the lead, held well in the stretch. KEYNES had good position on the inside, put in his bid on rail and was outfinished. JUSTICE EXPRESS set a pressured pace, weakened in deep stretch. BATES STORM stalked the pace three wide, had no rally.
