AHUEHUETE stalked the pace, rallied in the upper stretch four wide, closed fast and drew clear. SOPHIA'S MIGHTYMAN had a awkward start and trailed early, rallied in the stretch on the rail, finished well and was gaining. CHIQUITO KISSES dueled on the lead for a half, gained a clear in mid stretch, weakened late. LA GUERRE was well placed on the inside, angled out five wide in the stretch and rallied. RAT AWESOME never far back, did not threaten. PARADE IN BRAZIL dueled while between horses for a half, tired in mid stretch. A FACT IS A FACT pressed the pace three wide for five eights, gave way in late stretch. BLUEGRASS JOE raced wide and was outrun.
