CHIC CAT was allowed to settle early, rallied in the upper stretch five wide, closed fast and drew off. WHO'S THAT ONE stalked the pace on the inside, angled out four wide at the quarter pole, put in her bid in mid stretch and gained a slight lead, was outfinished late but was second best. YES LEE dueled on the lead, weakened slightly in the stretch. PYRITE BOB dueled for the lead from the inside, faltered in the stretch. FORMAL WHO never far back, lacked a late response and went evenly. ECHT slow early, found her best stride late. JOAN'S ROYAL DAWN stalked the pace in good position, had no rally. CONGARAA well placed early, lacked a late response. POLYNESIAN SUNSET was outrun.
