### Footnotes

FORMAL WHO steadied in the first turn on the inside, angled out three wide down the backside, rallied at the quarter pole, prevailed through a long drive under strong handling. TEAKOA well placed and saved ground, rallied in the stretch on the rail, just missed after a long stretch battle in a game effort. T. T.'S SURPRISE was never far back, rallied in the upper stretch, split horses and closed willingly. BELIEFITORKNOT dueled early, dropped back down the backside, went evenly in the stretch. CRYSTON dueled early, gained a clear lead down the backside, faltered in the stretch. SOLONG IRENE slow early, was never a threat. AREN'T OUI FANCY well placed early was through after a half.
