BLUES CROSSING broke sharply and quickly set the pace with a clear lead, led throughout and widened through the lane under strong handling. NADER stalked the pace, rallied three wide at the top of the stretch, was no match for the winner but was second best. ANDY O stalked the pace, lacked a late bid and went evenly in the stretch. TOUCH EM ALL tracked three wide, had no late kick. CHIEF COMMANDER allowed to settle while five wide, did not threaten. SLEWEY ARMSTRONG well placed early, dropped back. LARRY'S GETAWAY slow early, was always outrun. CALLING ALL SAINTS was no factor. GRIDIRON KEY chased from the inside, tired on the second turn. POPULAR DUDE saved ground early, dropped back after a half.
