BABA BOEY had speed from the start, moved up two wide into the turn, drew on even terms for the lead, dueled until deep stretch then edged clear under strong handling. REDO THE COURT battled for the lead between horses until late stretch then could not handle the winner but finished clear for second. CAMPBELL BEND forwardly placed from the start, advanced along the rail into the turn, was in tight nearing the quarter pole then finished with good courage. NO GRAY TWILIGHT contested the lead four wide until deep stretch then weakened. ACCORDING TO MIKE also battled for the early lead five wide then faded. SWOOPER disputed the pace between horses into the turn then weakened. FINAL QUEST had brief speed. S. R. LITTLE MAN was outrun. DEWDLE DAN lugged out from the start and was eased to the wire.
