GREAT CAUSE pressed the pace for three quarters, rallied at the quarter pole, drew off in the stretch under brisk handling. EYEGOTATRICKFORYOU had good position three wide throughout, could not challenge the winner late but held place. HARLAN PROSPECTOR well placed while between horses, finished willingly in the lane. TRACK RECORD was well placed and saved ground, angled out three wide in the upper stretch but needed more late. STILL SMOLDERING allowed to settle, failed to menace. MYASTORM set the pace with a clear lead, was hooked at the quarter pole and faded in the stretch. RAGASCO saved ground and was no threat. PRIME REALESTATE was outrun.
