TAXICAB outrun early, rallied determinedly along the rail to make the lead in deep stretch and proved best while drifting out under a hand ride. STEADY SMILER unhurried early, also moved up along the inside on the turn, rallied determinedly three wide through the stretch and just missed. MONO RIDGE with the second flight along the inside, angled out entering the stretch made the lead then could not handle the top two. JUMP BAIL was a sharp threat into the stretch then faded. STEPHEN'S GIFT went evenly. COFFEE STREET chased the leader for a half then weakened. DANGEL failed to menace. TUNNEL VISION was always outrun. ANOTHER ELUSIVE sprinted to a daylight lead soon after the start, set the pace into the stretch then flattened out. WHEN IT WAS trailed. CRYPTOGRAPHIC had brief speed.
