LARGEDOUBLEDOUBLE settled just off the leaders three wide into the second turn, rallied to make the lead, opened a clear advantage before the eighth pole, drifted out, dug in late and was all out to hold GENERAL LAFAYETTE safe. GENERAL LAFAYETTE outrun early, moved up steadily three wide on the second turn, was taken outside the leader at the top of the stretch, drew to that one late while being carried out but couldn't get by. KARLENS well placed from the start, bid along the rail entering the stretch then leveled off. MT. FUGI close up, swung widest of all and lost ground. CANADIAN HOME RUN set a pressured pace for six furlongs then weakened. HERE COMES BUBBA was outrun. FULL RATE prompted the pace outside for five and one half furlongs then stopped.
