REPENT IN TIME never far back, advanced steadily four wide on the second turn, made the lead late and drew clear under a strong hand ride. DINO DOMINIC sprinted up to make the lead on the first turn, set the pace until deep stretch then could not handle the winner. KING TANNER well placed from the start, gave up some ground on the second turn then came on again late three wide. BILLION BUCK BABY offered a mild bid along the inside on the second turn then leveled off. FIRM HAND chased the leader three wide into the stretch then weakened. REVERB failed to reach contention. MOUNT BREVETOR trailed into the stretch then passed tiring rivals. FATMANINHIPBOOTS was through after a half. MULTIPHONE was always outrun and eased to the wire.
