STAKES Best of Ohio Sprint S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD REGISTERED OHIO FOALS (WHICH REFLECTS \$65,000 FROM THE OHIO THOROUGHBRED FUND). Foaled in the State of Ohio as per the requirements set forth by the Ohio State Racing Commission. Nomination Fee is \$50, \$262 to enter, \$488 to start, with \$75,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth; 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Nominations Closed Tuesday September 22, 2009 with 20 Nominations. Weights Three Year Olds 119 lbs; Older 122 lbs; Fillies and Mares allowed 3 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box Tuesday September 29, 2009. A trophy to the winning Owner, Trainer & Jockey. This stake will not be split. Fees to be refunded to excluded horses. Each stake race shall consist of a maximum of fourteen (14) horses, eligibility to be determined by money earned. Eligible horses racing at least once in Ohio during 2009 credited with 2008 and 2009 earnings. Non Starters in Ohio during 2009 credited with 2009 earnings only. Should horses tie for eligibility, the following order will be used to determine participation. (a) Horses with the highest total earnings in the year of the stake and preceding year as published by Equibase; and (b) Lottery. (S)

TRI UIMET stalked I CANT REFUSE for half a mile, rallied in the upper stretch, prevailed through a long drive under strong handling. I CANT REFUSE was away alertly and set the pace with a clear lead, was hooked in mid stretch by the winner and held gamely to just miss. ROYAL NEMESIS stalked the pace from the inside, angled out in the upper stretch, closed fast and gaining. KING OF THE ROXY well placed throughout, had a mild bid but needed more late. DARCY BOY was allowed to settle, swung wide at the top of the stretch and had a late gain. INTOWNFORTHEDAY allowed to settle, failed to menace. PERFECTLY PLAYED was off a step slow and trailed early, never reached contention. TURNPIKE MIKE had good position for a half, weakened in the stretch. COLD TRIAL was never a threat. BEN'S REFLECTION wide early, dropped back in the stretch.
