PUT IT BACK TWENTY never far back, rallied steadily outside, made the lead inside the furlong marker and drew clear under a hand ride. SET THE STAGE away alertly, set the pace until deep stretch then could not handle the winner. MING DYNASTY unhurried early, closed a gap later. CAJUN PRIZE had speed from the start between horses, bid into the stretch then leveled off. PARTNER GEORGE well placed, lacked a closing response. SADLER POWER chased the leader for a half along the inside then gave way. THREEWISEMEN was outrun. DEVILS LUST had brief speed. HIGH SUCCESS was no factor.
