CIEN always within striking distance, engaged the pacesetter SARAH NICOLE in mid stretch and proved best under strong handling. SARAH NICOLE sprinted to a clear lead soon after the start, set the pace until deep stretch, dug in when joined by the winner but was not good enough. LITTLE BROWN BRICK settled just off the leaders and finished with good courage. CLASSIC NIX trailed for a half then rallied steadily when set down. BEDTIME LULLABY prompted the pace into the second turn, bid to be on near even terms for the lead at the quarter pole then came up empty. SON ET LUMIERE offered a mild bid on the second turn then flattened out. PATSY WON'T TELL was no threat. SMOKIN AFFAIR was outrun.
