MUSICAL MISCHIEF never far back, angled out four wide on the turn, rallied determinedly to make the lead late and won under mild urging. LA FORCE had speed from the start pressing the pace three wide, dropped towards the rail at the top of the stretch, made the lead near the sixteenth pole then could not handle the winner. HERE'STOTEPPERANCE away alertly, set a pressured pace until deep stretch then was outfinished while drifting out. EMOTIONAL AND FREE went evenly. REINE DES COEURS failed to menace. ANNIE'S GHOST was no threat. EVE THE DANCER had speed for a half then weakened. OUR STORMY GIRL was a sharp threat four wide for a half then stopped.
