P. P'S TO FOLLOW outrun into the stretch, swung widest of all out past the middle of the racetrack, rallied steadily and was along in time. DIDYAGETITDONE never far back, rallied along the rail into the stretch, inherited the lead late then could not handle the winner. SPIKE THE DIESEL away alertly, quickly opened a daylight lead, set the pace into the stretch, lugged out and was run down late. LIFEINTHETROPICS had speed from the start and finished with good courage three wide. BLACKFOOT TRAIL failed to menace. DAKOTA FREEWAY trailed well back while sluggish early and out in the middle of the racetrack, had a mild late rally. RAGASCO failed to reach contention. MY CALABRESE had brief speed. POP ON TOP was through after a half. RICHIE BY THE LAKE hung five wide, had speed into the stretch then gave way. BUSINESS FACTOR offered little.
