LADYS LOVE LIMOS allowed to settle, rallied through the stretch while four wide and finished willingly. FLOODGATE contended throughout, needed more late but finished willingly. CAN'T SNOW GEORGIE pressed the pace, put in a bid at the quarter pole, then flattened out in the stretch. MACHO MOON well placed, went evenly through the stretch. CUPID'S CONTRACT never far back, lacked a late response. SHELL WALLS was no factor. BAYSIDE BARON was outrun. MEMORY'S TERN trailed.
