J'S MARY JANE stalked the pace, rallied in the upper stretch three wide, prevailed through a long drive under strong handling. CRYPTIC MOON was never far back, rallied in the upper stretch on the inside, drifted out slightly in mid stretch, held gamely and just missed. SPEEDING TICKET set the pace with a clear lead, steadied slightly in mid stretch while between horses and weakened. LUV A MARINE well placed while four wide, needed more late and went evenly. OH SO SHINY allowed to settle early, closed a gap in the stretch. EMILY SUN SHINE flashed brief foot and was through early. A SLICK CHIC swung her head over bar before start, did not receive a fair start and was declared a non starter. The stewards posted the inquiry sign and the rider of SPEEDING TICKET claimed foul against the rider of CRYPTIC MOON. After viewing the tape the stewards ruled that A SLIGHT CHIC did not receive a fair and was declared her a non starter. All monies wagered on her where refunded. The stewards also disallowed the claim of foul lodged by the rider of SPEEDING TICKET.
