Footnotes

BLAZING BLING was away alertly and set the early pace through slow fractions, was hooked down the backside while racing on the rail, shook clear in the upper stretch and widened late under a hand ride. DENIRO'S SAINT stalked the early pace, rallied down the backside four wide and dueled with the winner, could not match strides through the lane but was second best. PYRITE BLUES raced close up three wide down the backside, could not challenge the top two in the lane but was best of the rest. SMALL TOWN FLIRT angled down to the rail soon after the start, had middle move while between horses down the backside, remained close until the quarter pole then faded in the stretch. AUTUMN FLING never far back early, gave way on the second turn. SHE'S THE PRIZE well placed and saved ground, tired after three quarters.
