SUNDAY LIBERTY away alertly, set the pace along the rail for nearly a half, angled two wide before the second turn, matched strides with ONE NICE ROANOKE the balance of the trip and proved best in a prolonged drive. ONE NICE ROANOKE prompted the pace two wide for a half, made the lead, dropped along the rail, dueled with the winner the balance of the trip and just missed hanging on. MISS KATY LAKE trailed for a half then closed willingly four wide. JULIETS SECRET never far back, moved up along the rail steadily then checked through the wire. A LITTLE PETITE well placed, failed to offer a closing response. BLACKTHORN ROSE failed to menace. D'WILD DAY was a sharp threat into the stretch then gave way.
