Footnotes

PAULIANO PKWY trailed into the stretch, accelerated rapidly while getting through between horses, drifted out late despite right handed urging made the lead late then bumped RIKIM at the wire. RIKIM close up from the start, rallied five wide into the stretch, was bumped by the winner at the wire and just missed. EXPRESS AIR allowed to settle while outside, closed willingly and checked at the wire as RIKIM was bumped and forced outward. BLAZING CITY never far back, rallied three wire into the stretch, made the lead near the furlong marker, drifted out and was outfinished. NOTGIVINMYLOVEAWAY battled for the lead along the rail until deep stretch then weakened. HIGH ACT had speed into the turn then faded. BEN'S BULLET dueled for the lead until mid stretch then tired. The rider of EXPRESS AIR lodged a claim of foul against the rider of the winner for interference nearing the wire. After reviewing the video tape replay the stewards upheld the original order of finish.
