CAJUN PRIZE never far back, moved up two wide on the turn, dropped to the rail entering the stretch, made the lead near the eighth pole and proved best under strong handling. FURKA PASS vied for the lead four wide from the start, loomed boldly five wide into the stretch then finished second best. FARLEYSHELONWHEELS outrun early, closed with a rush outside late. IFPUSHCOMESTOSHOVE found his best stride too late. NOTHING LIKE IT dueled for the lead between horses until deep stretch then was outfinished. PARTNER GEORGE well placed, lacked a closing response. CAST NO SHADOW was no threat. RHODESLEADTOHEAVEN set a pressured pace into the turn for nearly a half then gave way late. SOUND THE CHARGE was hustled up along the rail to be a sharp threat, had speed into the turn, checked near the quarter pole, stopped and returned sore.
