LICENSE TO BLING was away alertly and duelled for the early lead, shook clear and set the pace down the backside, was well handled on the front end and drew off in the stretch under left handed urging. DIAVOLETTTO well placed early, rallied on the second turn and drew close, could not gain in the stretch on the winner but was second best. MIDNIGHT VADER allowed to settle early, rallied in the stretch and closed willingly. DOCTOR DIEGO allowed to settle down the backside, had a mild rally while four wide. RUDYARD K raced in the second flight, rallied through the stretch and found his best stride late. NOT AN ALTAR BOY well placed and saved ground, had no rally. RISKY ROMANCE allowed to settle on the inside, lacked a late response. PREPAID

MINUTES raced mid pack and was no threat. FRED'S ALY slow early, was outrun. BRASS BUCKLE allowed to settle around the first turn, had a middle move down the backside, flattened out in the stretch. ALL SNUFFED UP well placed while three wide, tired. KIPLING BOY never far back early was through after a half. RED FRANCHISE chased the winner, gave way on the second turn.
