ONE DIXIE was unhurried early, rallied in the upper stretch while five wide, was full of run and drew clear late. FOREST LIGHT stalked the pace, rallied in the stretch, led between calls late and could not hold off the winner. ROCKER CHAD dueled on the lead and pressed the pace, held well through the stretch. BATES STORM pressed the early pace, rallied and gained a clear lead at the quarter pole, then weakened slightly late. GLITTER CANYON pressed the pace from the outside, lacked a late response and went evenly. BRICKLAND never far back, lacked a late kick. DIAMOND STEAL raced middle of the pack and was no threat. BETRUCKYTHANSMART failed to menace. REPRISAL was no factor. ALL PUMPED UP showed little.
