RUSSIAN WILD LIFE was unhurried early, rallied in the upper stretch, angled in mid stretch, edged clear late, driving. POR SUPUESTO set the pace through moderate fractions, held well and was caught late. READY TO EXCHANGE allowed to settle, rallied through the stretch, drew close, then was outfinished. SUPER MARKET stalked the pace, put in a bid in mid stretch, then hung. SNOW STOPPER never far back, lacked a late response and went evenly. SKYLAR'S DADDY never far back, rallied, upper stretch, bid flattened out. BLISS LANDING stalked the pace and was through after a half. ONE EYED WILLING was no factor. STORM DAMAGE trailed.
