SEVEN DAY FOOL prompted the pace two wide into the stretch, responded with a burst of speed late and drew clear under a hand ride. PANICUM set a pressured pace along the rail until deep stretch then could not handle the winner. TIME OUT TY settled mid pack along the inside, checked over heels on the middle of the turn then had a mild late rally. OUR CONCERTO had speed from the start, loomed boldly three wide on the turn then leveled off. CERRO AVILA failed to menace. KUFF EM was a sharp threat along the rail into the stretch then faded. LUCKY OKIE failed to offer a closing response. SKY TERRY offered little. RADICCHIO had brief speed.
