**Footnotes**

HE'S DOUBLEWIDE was well placed down the backside, rallied at the quarter pole and gained the lead, drew off in the stretch under a strong hand ride to win as much the best. HAMBONE vied for the lead on the rail, was no match for the winner through the stretch but held place. WOOD BE SWEET had good early position, swung wide in the stretch, lacked a late bid and went evenly. SAY HAY BY WAY allowed to settle early, was carried out in the upper stretch and lacked a late response. B MOORE BENTLEY allowed to settle, failed to menace. FIZZ ED was never a threat and bled. B K CONNECTION had speed for a half, folded up in the stretch. MA PETITE COQUETTE was outrun.
