YOUNG APOLLO stalked the pace setter, rallied at the quarter pole in the four path, drew off in the stretch while being ridden out. POR SUPUESTO set the pace and dueled on the lead, was no match for the winner through the lane but was second best. IRON WILLFUL well placed while three wide, lacked a late response and went evenly. FAST SUMMER raced middle of the pack on the inside, lacked a late response. COASTING IN allowed to settle, failed to menace. BACON AND RICE was never in contention. TALE OF THE COURT flashed brief foot while four wide and quickly tired.
