JACKANDIANE'S stalked the pace, rallied in the stretch three wide, closed determienly and was up in the final strides. MCLOY was away alertly and set the pace with a clear lead, remained clear in mid stretch and was caught late. ATTAWAY TOGO CHAMP never far back, rallied four wide in the stretch and finished well. SPEEDY GRAHAM chased the speed, needed more late but finished willingly. PRINCE DEVILLIER allowed to settle, swung wide in the stretch and closed a gap. IRISH SLICK not rushed early and saved ground, did not threaten. PACIFIC INVASION allowed to settle, failed to menace. TRIPLE JIG had no speed, lost contact and was eased on the turn.
