COOKIE'S GOLD never far back, advanced steadily on the backstretch, made the lead on the second turn, set the balance of the pace and drew off under mild pressure. NO EXPOSURE outrun into the second turn, rallied determinedly four wide through the stretch and finished clear for second. B L'S SASSY away alertly, set the pace for five and one half furlongs then was outfinished. SISTER NAN passed tiring rivals late. BAJAN RIHANNA well placed, lacked a closing response. M. J. EXPRESS was outrun. OHBEEGEEWHYEN was not a threat. L'IL MISS SUNSHINE had her head turned at the start, hopped, rushed to contention before a quarter, had speed for six furlongs then tired. SUMMER MONEY dueled for the early lead, had speed for a half then stopped.
