Footnotes

WOOD ALLEY set the early pace, repulsed a bid at the quarter pole, drew clear in the lane, driving. DAKOTA FREEWAY was never far back, rallied up the inside and was up for second. TABULATE well placed early, rallied at the quarter pole and got close, put in his bid, then hung. GEODI'S GOLD allowed to settle early, rallied in the stretch and finished well. ABISTRABI raced four wide throughout, lacked a late response and went evenly. STATE OF THE ART well placed and saved ground, lacked a late kick. MARTANGO wide early, was no threat. BOTTLE OF SMOKE pressed the pace, flattened out in mid stretch.
