JAKES STORM BUCK allowed to settle early, had a mild rally in the stretch while no threat. BLAZING CITY never far back, lacked a late response. LEDGEHILL pressed the pace for a half, gave way in the stretch. OUR BOY BLUE flashed brief foot and was through early.
