KLASSI BERTI stalked the early pace, was in tight while between horses at the three eight pole, angled out at the top of the stretch, closed determienly and drew clear. WILD ALEX dueled early, gained a clear lead at the quarter pole, remained clear in mid stretch, could not hold off the winner late but was second best. KING OF T MOUNTAIN well placed throughout while three wide, finished willingly but needed more late. FLASHY DANCER unhurried early, improved his position while no threat. BOCA PASS vied for the lead for a half, weakened in the stretch. DUKE SKYWALKER never far back, had no rally.
