PRIZES INCLUDED had speed from the start, vied for the lead three wide while patiently handled, responded when set down entering the stretch, made the lead near the furlong marker and won going away. KEG away alertly, set the pace until mid stretch then could not handle the winner. ROBYNS AFAIR altered course sharply to the outside entering the first turn, offered a mild bid on the second turn then finished evenly. SEIZE THE FIRE was sharply righted at the start, was forced wide entering the first turn then failed to reach contention. STRATEGIC DECISION was a sharp threat along the inside for a half then gave way. CLASSIC REWARD was through early. The stewards posted the inquiry sign and the rider of SEIZE THE FIRE lodged a claim of foul against the rider of ROBYNS AFAIR for alleged interference entering the first turn, After review the stewards upheld the original order of finish.
