D'S DESSERT stalked the pace, rallied on the second turn, drew clear in the stretch and maintained his advantage under right handed urging. CHOP SPATS unhurried early, rallied through the stretch, finished well and was up for second. FOREST PICNIC never far back, rallied in the upper stretch while three wide and closed willingly. BOBBIE'S DEVIL set the pace and dueled on the lead, weakened slightly. REAL ECHO in the second flight was no threat. RHODESLEADTOHEAVEN chased the early speed, dueled for the lead until the second turn, then came up empty. WHO SLEW WHO was no factor. TURNPIKE MIKE well placed early, dropped back.
