DUE TO FLY settled just off the leaders three wide, made the lead entering the stretch, set the balance of the pace and prevailed under mild urging. OHIO VOLUNTEER outrun early, saved ground along the rail, moved to the leaders at the eighth pole then finished second best. SHANEES never far back, advanced two wide on the turn, was taken out three wide at the top of the stretch then finished willingly. SATIN ROSE was hustled up along the inside to battle for the early lead, inherited a clear advantage on the turn, set the pace into the stretch then was outfinished. ON JODI'S ACCOUNT close up from the start, failed to offer a closing response. TOMMYS JET was not a threat. SKITZI had brief speed. DASHFORTHROSES contested the early lead two wide and gave way on the turn. THAT'S OUR CACHE broke slowly then trailed.
